At the conclusion of Thursday evening's program at which Roy spoke, I privately presented the Tenth District's \$250 donation check to him. This donation, combined with the \$250 donation made to A Safe Place at our April District meeting, completes the budgeted amount of \$500 for this President's Special Emphases giving for 2012-2013.
