In case you haven't heard, one of the major highlights that occurred at the GFWC Illinois 118th Annual Convention held in May was the passage of amendments to the State Bylaws which affects the number of club delegates at state convention. The change in the Representation section now defines club delegates (those allowed to vote) as "Any member in good standing may attend Convention as a delegate." With this change, there are no limits on the number of delegates from any club based on the number of members of the club. As an example, small clubs (less than 25 members) previously were limited to two delegates at Convention. With the change, if said club has four members attending Convention, all four can vote if they paid registration fees for the entire Convention.

Many reservations have already been received for our upcoming Ways & Means event on Friday, October 4, at Arboretum Club in Buffalo Grove. With GFWC Past President Jackie Pierce presenting a program on the life of child actress Shirley Temple, as well as the Silent Auction and Large Raffle being conducted, I know this will be an event you will not want to miss! I encourage club members to also invite non-member friends and family to attend with them. Jackie's past presentations of famous women in history have been outstanding and I'm sure this one will also be memorable. If you cannot attend, purchase your raffle tickets in advance through your Club President as you do not have to be present to be a winner. But, plan to attend and be a part of the fun and camaraderie.

Our neighboring Illinois districts have also been invited to join us.

A few facts regarding the proper approach to presenting a report, before you ever speak remember your appearance speaks volumes. Don't carry loose papers to the podium, your written reports should be in a folder or attached to a clip board. If there is a podium, the papers are placed on the podium, if there is no podium, firmly hold the folder or clip board so that hands and papers do not shake. Before you begin the proper address is "Madam President" or "Madam Chairman" or you may begin with the words, "Thank you Madam President. Speak to be heard, do not read report word for word with head bowed, make eye contact with the audience and remember, written copies of your report should be given to the Recording Secretary, so they may be recorded to the minutes of that meeting. The report should be typed in bold print, always keep a copy of your report and supplementary materials for one's file. REMEMBER...A SUCCESSFUL REPORT IS ONE THAT IS: INFORMED, ENTHUSIASTIC, AND POSITIVE.

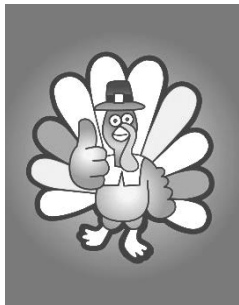

VILLAGE PRESIDENT PROCLAIMS MORTON GROVE WOMAN'S CLUB DAY

At a Regular Village Board Meeting, Morton Grove Village President Daniel DiMaria declared July 8, 2013 as Morton Grove Woman's Club Day in honor of the club's SIXTIETH ANNIVERSARY.
